Payment will be taken when the online entry is submitted.</li> <li>Entry by telephone is not accepted.</li> <li>It is the entrant's responsibility to check their entry has been received before the closing date. Junior Tour will not be responsible for entries which are lost or arrive after the closing date.</li> <li>An entry fee will only be refunded if the entrant confirms their withdrawal prior to the closing date of entries or if they fail to gain entry to the championship.</li> <li>Updated entry lists will be available for entrants to view on <a href="http://www.scottishgolf.org">www.scottishgolf.org</a>.</li> <li>Should a category fail to reach its starting field then entrants on the other reserve list will be entered until the maximum field of 72 players is achieved.</li> </ul>	
RESERVES	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Entrants who fail to gain entry will be allocated to a reserve list by order of handicap.</li> <li>Junior Tour will manage a reserve list. Should a place in the draw become available, reserves will be invited in the order they are listed on the reserve list.</li> </ul>	

- Should a reserve be unable to be reached, Junior Tour by reserve the right to contact the next reserve.
- Refund of entry fees will be issued to those entrants who fail to gain entry within 28 days of the championship.

### WITHDRAWALS

- In the event of a competitor having to withdraw after the closing date, the entry fee will not be refunded.
- Withdrawal of an entry prior to the closing date will incur an administrative charge of £5.
- Withdrawals will not be permitted at any time unless confirmed by email to Paul Gibson - [paulgibson6@hotmail.com](mailto:paulgibson6@hotmail.com).
- A competitor is not allowed to withdraw at any stage of the championship except for emergency reasons or medical circumstances accepted by Junior Tour.
- Competitors who fail to show for their tee time may not be permitted to compete in future editions of the tournament.

### QUALIFICATION

To be eligible entrants must meet the following criteria

#### Boys

- Male and of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- U18 Category: Be under the age of 18 years on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.
- U16 Category: Be under the age of 16 years on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.
- Either have been born in Scotland, have one parent or grandparent born in Scotland or have residency in Scotland for not less than 3 years
- Not have played for any other country's international team at under 18 or higher.
- Be in possession of a handicap not exceeding 6.4 for Under 18 category and 10.4 for Under 16 category.

#### Girls

- Female and of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- Be under the age of 18 years on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.
- Either have been born in Scotland, have one parent or grandparent born in Scotland or have residency in Scotland for not less than 3 years
- Not have played for any other country's international team at under 18 or higher.
- Be in possession of a handicap not exceeding 34.4.

### CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- The tournament will comprise of 36 holes of stroke play over 1 day.
- There will be no cut.
- The winner of the event shall be the competitor who returns the lowest GROSS score for 36 holes in each category. There will also be a winner for U18 girls, lowest NETT score.
- In the event of a tie after 36 holes, the event will go to a card playoff best 2<sup>nd</sup> round, back 9, best last 6 holes, best last 3 holes.
- Caddies are not permitted.
- Parents / guardians / relatives may not walk on the fairways or speak to competitors during play.

This process will continue until there are 10 players in each section</li> </ul>
