Role Description

Main duties include:

- To work in conjunction with the Course Rating Team Leader to deliver the annual Scottish Golf Course Rating Programme;
- Conduct course ratings using the USGA Course Rating System;
- Undertake measurements of obstacle factors using a stimpmeter, yardage wheel and other relevant equipment.

- Well organised;
- Enthusiastic and passionate about the game of golf;
- An appreciation of how the golf course is played by a variety of players;
- Good communicator;
- Friendly and able to work with other people;
- Confident with the handling of data and numbers;
- Prepared to make a time commitment;
- Attend Scottish Golf Course Rating Accreditation/Training;

Time Commitment Required:

All Team Members are required to complete a full accreditation process consisting of;

- An Introductory One- Day Course;
- "Homework" of approximately 3 hours;
- Shadow an existing team on two course ratings;
- Rate 5 golf holes and complete a USGA calibration quiz (25 questions) to become accredited;
- Following completion of accreditation, an estimated 7-10 days per year will be spent on course rating visits. Typically rating trips are undertaken on weekdays between the months of May and September.
